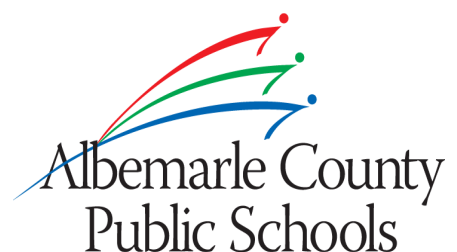

Registration Form

Registration is required for all ESOL classes. You may register on-site for the General ESOL and GED for ESOL classes at Albemarle High School. For specialized classes, please pre-register by filling out this form. Tuition is payable in advance, and is non-refundable after the first day of class.

Students interested in taking multiple classes may not be required to pay tuition for each class.

Classes must have a minimum of seven students to be offered. Class size is limited to 15 students per class, except for the General ESOL classes at Albemarle High School. If the minimum number of students is not met, the class will be cancelled and all tuition refunded.

Registration forms must be accompanied by a deposit of \$50 for all specialized classes. Please do not send cash in the mail. Checks may be payable to Albemarle County Schools. We are unable to accept credit or debit cards.
